Good things come in threes: new mobile crane for Mantovani Global Services Srl

- LTM 1150-5.3 becomes the third mobile crane of Mantovani's fleet

The crane has a 66-metre-telescopic boom and when fully extended, it can lift more than nine tonnes. "Indeed, it can complete lots of jobs without requiring additional ballast transport vehicles", says Mantovani.
